

Installation instructions

Please read these instructions carefully before hanging this wallcovering. It is advisable that a professional decorator is used. **If you have any questions please contact us before installing.**

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Before cutting and hanging this wallcovering, ensure that all rolls have the same batch reference, are in good condition, have no shade variation and that no other faults are present. Please ensure that there are enough rolls to complete the job. Examination before hanging is the buyer's responsibility. No claim can be accepted for hanging incorrect wallcoverings or after wallpapers have been cut and hung showing defects that were apparent at time of hanging or for consequential loss.

- This product consists of three panels supplied and printed as one continuous roll. Each panel measures 27" wide x 118" high (68.6cm wide x 300cm high).
- Take extra care when papering around electric light switches and power points. Do not allow moisture to drip onto electrical contacts.

PREPARATION

- Walls should be clean, dry and even.
- Prepare wall by removing all traces of dirt, old wallpaper, or loose paint.
- Do not hang wallcoverings on any wall with a history of damp.
- Fill any cracks and allow to dry before hanging.
- Absorbent surfaces should be appropriately sized using a diluted wallpaper adhesive. Sealed walls, i.e. painted should be rubbed with sandpaper to create a 'key'.

• It is important that the walls are of an even and consistent colour. If they are not then consideration should be given to painting them with an appropriate colourwash. Alternatively, we recommend that walls be 'lined' horizontally using a good quality lining paper. Allow this to fully dry.

HANGING

- This is a 'paste the wall product'. The decorator should paste the wall and not the back of the wallcovering.
- We recommend the use of a light ready mixed adhesive. Evenly apply the adhesive directly onto the wall using a brush or a short pile emulsion roller.
- Paste should be evenly applied to the wall to hang one length at a time.
- Apply the wallcovering to the wall and smooth down with a good quality hanging brush or plastic spatula.
- Do not overlap, use butt joins.
- Carefully wipe any excess paste from the face of the paper immediately with a clean damp sponge before it dries.
- After hanging 2 or 3 lengths, inspect the results to ensure that there is no shading or other fault.

No claims for hanging costs will be allowed for goods hung in excess of one roll.

CARE

Wipe with a soft cloth and clean water. Oils, fats and solvent based stains are not expected to be removable.
