BEFORE YOU START PLEASE ENSURE THE FOLLOWING

▼ The wallcoverings are as ordered

as specified as labelled

(Identification samples available immediately)

▼ You have sufficient material to complete the job in the same batch

▼ Batch numbers are identical never mix batches on the wall

never in fill with off-cuts

▼ The correct adhesive for your individual site circumstances

▼ Adequate site conditions good lighting for correct inspection

minimum ambient temperature of 10°C. 50°F. good ventilation & clean working conditions

Avoid excessive ambient temperatures radiators should ideally be removed before and for 24

hours after hanging. If this is not possible they must be turned off and kept off until the wallcovering has fully

dried

▼ Trial hang of 3 drops inspect after each drop

inspect after one hour

N.B. Joints on some designs such as woven textiles, grass cloths and other horizontal patterns will be visible and may give a 'panelled' effect.

STOP IMMEDIATELY IF THE RESULT LOOKS UNACCEPTABLE

Continue inspection throughout hanging process, inspecting each drop as you hang it

Never assume shading will dry out

No claims will be accepted for hanging charges beyond 3 drops or for consequential loss

SURFACE PREPARATION

Correct identification of surfaces, and the appropriate preparation is critical to successful hanging.

Unless otherwise instructed the adhesive supplied will be suitable for correctly prepared absorbent surfaces.

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK INDIVIDUAL SITE CIRCUMSTANCES

- To correctly identify the surface onto which you are hanging
- To determine the correct surface preparation for your site circumstances

SURFACE PREPARATION – GENERAL GUIDANCE

Differing designs will have different masking capabilities. Plain designs will be less forgiving of poor wall surfaces All surfaces should be:

▼ Clean Remove all surface contamination, e.g. dirt, grease and pigmented marks, e.g. felt pen

etc. Wash off using a detergent solution, rinse and allow to dry thoroughly.

▼ Sound & Even Free of flaking paint, old wallpapers/backing. Evidence of previous adhesive should be

removed with hot water. Weak skims/surfaces and uneven surfaces will require

remedial action.

▼ Uniform in Colour To prevent show through equalise colour.

Treated for Mould Treat with fungicidal wash in accordance with pack instructions.

▼ Dry in Depth Tested with good moisture meter.

▼ Keyed With coarse, dry sandpaper.

(Particularly adjacent to painted woodwork).

SURFACE PREPARATION - SPECIFIC SURFACES

TYPICAL ABSORBENT SURFACES

Uncoated plaster, Plasterboard, Wood Most water based paints (matt) Dry wall sealer (if correctly applied) Primer sealer (if correctly applied)

TREATMENT

- Carry out initial preparation outlined above
- Prime with Dixon Turner primer sealer (following instructions on the tub)
- Similar surfaces can have differing absorption rates. Eg, with plaster, both the mix and application can affect absorption. Consequently these recommendations with regards to primer sealer can only be guidelines and may have to be adjusted for specific site circumstances.
- Hang wallcovering using recommended undiluted adhesive
- N.B. Wooden surfaces may require specific preparation.

TYPICAL NON ABSORBENT SURFACES

Formica, Glassfibre, Metal
Most oil based paints (gloss, vinyl silk)
Dry wall sealer (if heavily applied or multicoats)
Primer sealer (if not diluted correctly)
Previously decorated surfaces – porosity
may be reduced by successive coats of adhesive
Heavily troweled Plaster

TREATMENT

- Carry out initial preparation as outlined above (making sure of good key)
- Hang wallcovering using VOV non absorbent surface adhesive – do not dilute
- N.B. Metal surfaces will require specialist Primers appropriate to the metal.

HANGING THE WALLCOVERINGS

| Wide width Fabric backed Vinyl | Dixon Turner Heavy or Strippable on plasterboard | Wall | Reverse alternate drops (Unless directed otherwise in roll) | Overlap 50mm and trim using joint cutter |
| Glassfibre | Dixon Turner Standard | Wall | Do not reverse | Butt Join |
| Textiles | Enquire or see instructions in roll | Enquire or see roll | Do not reverse | Butt |
| N.B. Some fabric backing can look like paper e.g. non woven polyester. If in doubt please check | Do not dilute | Pre pasted vinyl should not need further adhesives | Number length in Pencil on reverse | Take care not to cut through into substrate |

N.B. Adhesives contain fungicides. Keep away from children and animals. Wash hands frequently and wear gloves or barrier cream. The use of non approved adhesive could invalidate fire certificates.

HANGING TIPS

- Start in a corner nearest the main light source and plumb the first length.
- Always use rolls (when numbered) sequentially, hanging the highest number first.
- Always number the top of each drop as you cut it, in pencil on the back, to ensure a safe system of reversal or straight hanging.
- Never in fill with off cuts over doors or windows etc use only full width product in roll sequence.
- ▼ Join in corners using correct edge. Do not join a middle to an edge.
- Use spatula in an up and down direction only. For Textiles and Glassfibre use a Rubber or Plastic Roller.
- Do not overwork joints, use only a spatula or soft roller.
- ▼ On textiles, use clean off-cuts face to face over joint and lightly roll back never on face of the wallcovering.
- Allow material to settle for 10 15 minutes prior to trimming top and bottom.
- When overlapping and trimming use a straight edge and take care not to cut through into the substrate. For paper backed vinyl use a protection strip. For fabric backed vinyl use a joint cutter.
- Take care not to get adhesive onto the surface of the wallcovering remember it is designed to stick!
- ▼ Inspect each drop as you hang it. Stop immediately if the result looks unacceptable.
- N.B. Textile wallcoverings requires careful storage (not on edge), very clean site conditions/tools etc, and delicate handling.

If stains remain within the texture of the vinyl, we recommend the use of a fine bristle brush in conjunction with the suggested cleaning fluid.

N.B. It is always important to act immediately to remove stains - old stains may not be removable.
